Object: Health documentation required of volunteer visitors (healthcare profile) of the Fondazione IRCCS San Gerardo dei Tintori - Requirements for new applications.

In the light of the National Vaccine Prevention Plan and the national and international epidemiological changes which increasingly see the onset of epidemics of infectious diseases preventable by vaccination (e.g. measles), in order to ensure adequate protection for oneself, for staff and users, we inform you that it is the decision of this IRCCS to require those who intend to attend the Fondazione in any capacity, to demonstrate individual protection against potentially dangerous infectious diseases.

Therefore interested parties, together with the attendance request form, must produce the following documents:

• vaccination certificate complete with all vaccinations received, in particular including:

- 1. hepatitis-B vaccination;
- 2. trivalent measles-mumps-rubella vaccination (at least two doses) or documentation proving the natural disease,

• certificate of execution of the tuberculin skin test (TST) or IGRA test (carried out no more than three months before the request). If TST / IGRA is positive, chest x-rays should be provided

• any supplementary serological tests, mandatory if it is not possible to demonstrate natural immunization (eg antibody titration for HBV, HCV, measles, mumps, rubella, varicella).

It is specified that, in the event of lack of these requirements, the IRCCS San Gerardo dei Tintori Foundation reserves the right to reject the request for authorization to attend.

It is specified that the delivery of any missing vaccinations will not be carried out by this Foundation IRCCS but by the Vaccination Centers competent for the territory of residence.
